3D Police Car Model

Assembly Instructions

NB To ensure the model stays in one piece after assembly it is advisable to use a tiny drop of superglue to lock pieces together.

Before glueing any parts make sure you are assembling the model correctly by making it up without glue first.

Each piece of the model is numbered for easy assembly.

The letters are the body parts and the numbers are the slots on the parts.

To prevent parts from breaking, remove carefully.

- 1. Internal car frame assembly- (A), (A2), (B1), (B2), (C1), (C2), (D1) & (D2)
 - a. Attach axle 13 & 12 to slots 1 & 2 on the frame
 - b. Attach seats (1) & (2) to slot (3)
 - c. Attach second set of seats (1) & (2) to slot (4)
 - d. Slide (F) into slot (5)
 - e. Attach bonnet 📵 onto slot 🕜
- 2. Attach 11 to 15 only using slot 11A
- 3. Slide (A) on bonnet (2) into slot (9A)
- 4. Attach 12 to frame by sliding 18 into slot 19 and joining 15 to slot 18
- 5. Attach front lights **M** onto **1**, with the lights facing away from the slots.
 - a. Slide assembled lights into slot 6 on A and 2 and slot 10 on outer body 10 & 102
- 6. Slide rear bumper **H** into slots **(A)** to **(b)** on rear of vehicle.
- 7. Attach rear lights N onto slots 12
- 8. Attach boot lid (to slot 13 on (& (22)
- 9. Slide steering wheel P to slot 14
- 10. Slide windows **(G)** front and rear into slots **(15)**
- 11. Attach siren Bar R onto S and attach completed assembly to roof 1
- 12. Attach assembled roof **1** to top of vehicle.
- 13. Attach mirrors 1 to 8A & 8B respectively.
- 14. Assemble wheels **U**, by placing two together with designs facing outwards and slide on axle.
- 15. Slide the wheel locking nut **v** onto the axle slot **6**.

Finally, complete the car by placing the bull bar \mathbf{W} into slots $\mathbf{m} \times 2$ on the front of the vehicle.
