# 3D VW Fusca Cabriolet Beetle Laser Cut Model

# **Assembly Instructions**

NB To ensure the model stays in one piece after assembly it is advisable to use a tiny drop of superglue to lock pieces together.

Before you use superglue to permanently glue the VW Beetle together, use a small ball of prestik to hold the pieces in place to ensure they all fit, allowing you to dismantle it if required.

Each piece of the model is numbered for easy assembly.

The Numbers are the aeroplane parts and the Letters are the slots on the parts.

#### To prevent parts from breaking, remove carefully.

#### Vehicle Undercarriage Assembly

- 1. Remove vehicle main base 1, side internal frames 2A, 2B and the centre frame 3.
- 2. Take out the small rectangular pieces slots (A) from the main base.
- 3. Attach frames to base, ensuring that the slots (A) face forward.
- 4. Place rear body panel 4 into slot B on centre frame 3 and slots C on internal frames 2 & 2B. Slide the body panel 5 above part 4 into slots.
- 5. To add stability and a guide for the horizontal body parts on the model, remove wheel arch (1). Glue parts if required. Leave some flexibility.
- 6. Slide body part 6 into slot (K), then place body part 7 above part 6 using slot (L) on the centre frame.

#### Vehicle Body Assembly

- 7. Remove front body panels parts 9 to 13 and assemble as such:
  - Part  $\bigcirc$  into slot (M),  $\bigcirc$  into (N),  $\bigcirc$  into (P),  $\bigcirc$  into (Q) and  $\bigcirc$  into (R).
- 8. Attach rear seat base 16 onto slots (T) and rear seat cushion 17 into slot (H).
- 9. Place rear body 14 into slots (G) near rear wheel arch. Place part 15 into slots (F).
- 10. Place front seat base 18 onto slot (U) and front seat cushion 19 on slot (V).
- 11. Assemble the bonnet by first removing the bonnet struts 20 on the vehicle base and place them into slots (W) with details facing outwards.
- 12. Use bonnet parts 21 to 26 as such:
  Part 21 to slot (X), 22 to (Y), 23 to (Z), 24 to (AA) and 25 to (BB).

# **Steering Console & Window Assembly**

- Gently remove steering wheel components 27, 28 and dashboard 29, attach steering column 28 to dashboard 29 using slot (DD). Place steering wheel 27 onto part 28, attach completed assembly into slot (EE) on side frame 2A & 2B.
- 14. Insert front windscreen 30 into slot between dashboard and centre frame (FF). Complete bonnet assembly by placing part 26 in front of the windscreen into slots (CC) on the bonnet struts.

### **Doors & Engine Body Assembly**

- 15. Attach side door panels 1 onto each side of the vehicle, ensuring details face away from the vehicle. Remove door handles 2 and place into slots GG.
- 16. Gently remove engine struts 33 and attach to speaker shelf 34 using slots (HH) so that they point towards the back of the vehicle angled down. Attach assembly to side door panels using slot (JJ).
- 17. Slide engine cover 35 onto slot (KK) on the struts. Slide part 36 below cover on provided slot (LL).
- 18. Assemble vehicle roof canopy, by taking parts 37 and attaching to slots (MM) on the speaker board so that the two slots face away from the vehicle. Place roof parts 38 into slots (NN).

# **Final Body Work**

- 19. Attach rear lights 3 to slots protruding out of vehicle 2 & 2 on slots ©. Remove front lights 4 and place onto protruding parts (PP).
- Attach rear bumper 41 and rear bumper holders 42 to back of vehicle using large slots QQ. Using bumper struts 43 place into slots RR to complete the bumper.
- 21. Attach front bumper struts 44 in the same manner as above to front bumper using slots @ with the front bumper part 45. Add parts 46 to the front of the bumper using slots SS.
- 22. Attach the front number plates 48 to slot (T) below front bumper and to slot (C) on the rear of the vehicle.
- 23. To assemble the side door mirrors, remove mirror holder 49 and place on slot (VV) on side door panel, then place mirror 60 onto mirror holder, so that mirror faces the back of the vehicle.

# Wheel Assembly - Single Wheel - Repeat for remaining

- 24. Remove and place in order the inner wheel side wall 61, inner wheels 62, 63 and outer wheel side wall 64. To hold the wheel together, use 5 of wheel spokes parts 65 and place into aligned slots on the wheel pieces.
- 25. Attach wheel axle 56 onto the vehicle main base with the smaller edge underneath into slots (WW).
- 26. Slide completed wheel assembly onto axle.
